

# Delta Pride 2018 Camper Rules

- All medications, over the counter and prescription will be turned in upon arrival at camp. The camp nurse will distribute all medications to the camper throughout camp as directed in the medical release form or prescription instructions. Medications will be given back to the campers at check out on the 9th.
- Campers and Counselors will be following the tri-buddy system. This means there should be at least 3 people to every group when traveling between activities, meals, and workshops. The 3 people must consist of at least one camper and one counselor.
- Respect is extremely important. Campers should respect their counselors, Wesley staff, A- State staff, volunteers, and each other.
- Dress Code: Shorts must be at least fingertip length; No sagging of the pants; No pajamas during daily activities; No cleavage showing or bare midriffs; No underwear showing; No bras or bra straps showing. ANY adult leader has final veto power on all wardrobe choices. Leave no room for doubt! If it's questionable, the answer is going to be NO.
- Sleep! Lights out means everyone needs to be in his or her assigned rooms, in bed, with the lights out. No wondering around or leaving the room. • Be on time for everything!
- Drink lots of water!
- Phones are not allowed during camp activities. Counselors reserve the right to take away phones if they become an issue at any point during camp.
- Girls stay on the girl's wing/floor and boys stay on the boy's wing/floor in the dorm. Meet in the common area if you need to talk to a member of the opposite sex while we are in the dorm.
- Keep your Bible handy! You'll need them for Bible Studies and night devotionals.
- No PDA & No Purple! Girls are pink and boys are blue. Blue + Pink = Purple. No Purple! Everyone is single at camp this week.
- Showers are mandatory!
- Clean up after yourselves! At Wesley, in the dorm, in the cafeteria, everywhere. Don't leave a mess for someone else to clean for you.
- No drugs, alcohol, fireworks, paraphernalia, weapons of any kind, medications, or other questionable items.
