

A-State Wesley Foundation Delta Pride Assistant Director

Wesley is hiring an assistant camp director for Delta Pride Summer camp July 9-13, 2019. Applicants should be at least sophomores in the fall of 2019 and have a 2.5 GPA or above. Experience as a counselor or camper at Delta Pride is preferred, but not required. The assistant director will receive a \$500 stipend. They will be responsible for assisting the camp director in preparing for camp and executing a well-run summer program. The assistant director will report to the campus minister, but work closely alongside the camp director. Their duties will include the following:

Recruitment: Working alongside the camp director to develop informational brochures, applications, and online materials for Delta Pride. Mailing out said information to youth groups in the Northeast District. Contacting former campers about returning to camp in the summer. This may require visiting some local congregations to speak about the camp experience.

Administration: Helping the camp director to facilitate relationships between different offices on campus like Residence Life, Dining Services, and Card Services. They will provide support for developing the schedule of camp, determining camp activities, and coordinating volunteers both before and during camp.

Leadership: The assistant camp director will show leadership among the camp counselors by leading at least one workshop for campers. They will provide at least one training for incoming counselors and assist the camp director in any duties that need to be fulfilled.

Preferred applicants have a heart for serving. They are ready and willing to be used by God to transform lives, communities, and the world starting with the youth of the Northeast District. They are committed to being a good role model for campers as well as their fellow students. They seek to live their life in a Christ-like manner.
